**Overview**

Veterinarians treat animal health problems. They work to prevent and cure diseases in animals. They also treat injuries such as wounds and broken bones. Some work with pets and others work with farm or zoo animals. Some do research or inspect meat at food processing plants.

They have varied duties.

- Talk with owners about how to care for and breed animals.
- Check animals and order lab tests to find health problems.
- Diagnose and treat health problems.
- Prescribe and give drugs and shots to treat and prevent disease.
- Do surgery and set bones.
- Put "to sleep" animals that are too ill.
- Keep medical records up to date.
- Direct and train staff in the handling and care of animals.
- Talk with zoos and aquariums about the care, sale, or trade of animals.
